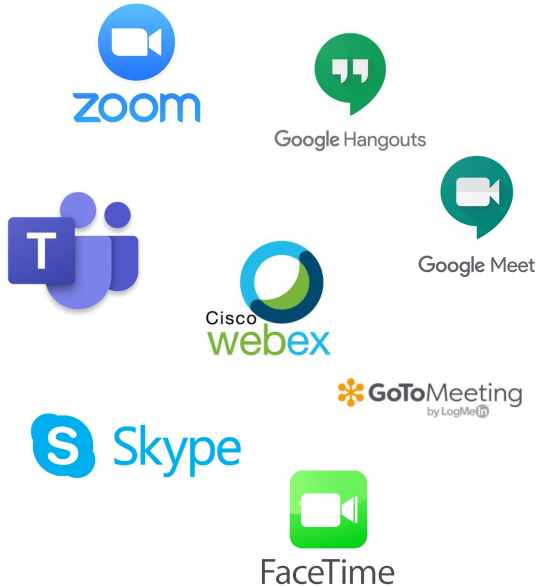

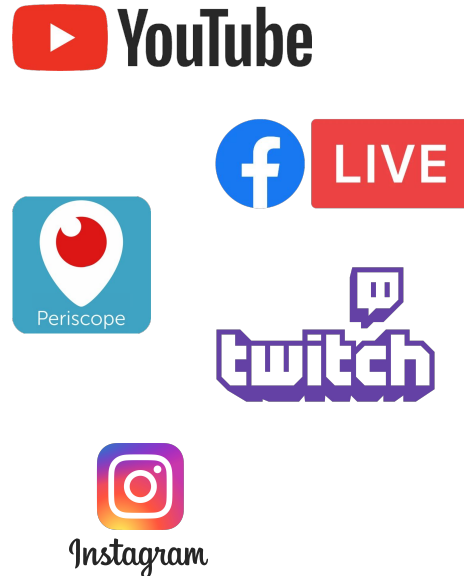

Works on a phone, tablet, or desktop

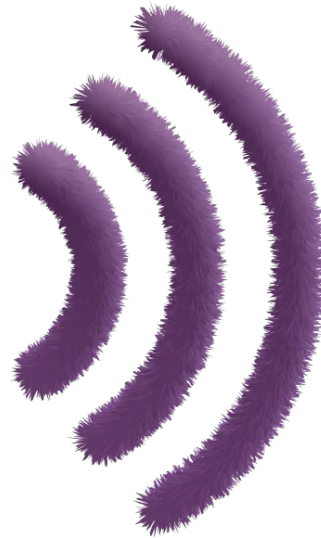
Most software is free for basic features
